## Track Days Chief – Informational Welcome Letter

**Gabe Estrada** here, and as Track Days Chief for 2026, I would like to welcome you to another Cal Club Track Days event for 2026. It is my hope that you have a fun, safe and enjoyable weekend here with us!

This event is run in conjunction with the Cal Club Racing Championships. **The Track Days group will be referred to as Run Group #1** and will run 3 sessions (20min ea) on Saturday and Sunday, resulting in 1 hour each day. For reference, see the included track maps on Page 3 below. You can also find a copy at registration

All participants must Register/Check-In IN THE BIG Main Building at the Circuit, prior to getting their vehicle tech'd and before the drivers meeting.

Participants must attend all meetings that are held by the Track Days Chief and/or the identified Instructors. Mandatory meetings will be held each morning prior to the first on-track session of the day. Additionally, a short mandatory debrief meeting will occur after each on-track session.

All vehicles must complete a self-tech sheet before approval by Track Days Staff. A tech sticker will then be issued/placed on the approved vehicle. **No vehicle will be allowed on track without a Track Day Tech Sticker.**

As a reminder, approved helmets are required. Long sleeves and gloves are suggested but not required. If you do not have an approved helmet, the track should/will have rentals available.

**Saturday and Sunday:** Please assemble near my Motorhome (look for the Track Day Banner) **6:45 am** – look for our white/tan motorhome and black dually truck. We will have cars tech'd followed by a quick **driver meeting at 7:15 am each day**. We will cover the basics of driving on a racetrack, outline strict passing zones, discuss overall track safety and answer any initial questions. **Our first session is at 8:00am, so by 7:45am we will head over to pre-grid** to line up for our session. Grid for us is on the East (Freeway) side of the Race Control building.

**For important course familiarization, the first session of each day**, we will start with a two-lap lead-follow, which will be led by a designated Pace-Car indicated with flashing hazards. We will then pull into hot pits, do a quick driver check, then release cars back on course for the remainder of the 20-minute session.

Thank you for spending your weekend with Cal Club. I look forward to seeing you early on Saturday and/or Sunday morning!

## TRACK DAYS SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS

This event is held under the current Sports Car Club of America (SCCA) Track Day rules and regulations <https://www.scca.com/downloads/44505-scca-track-event-rules/download> and these Supplemental Regulations.

### I. **REGISTRATION and FEES**

#### A. **WEEKEND ENTRY FEES:**

Weekend fees for this event:

- \$225 for the weekend (2-days)
- \$150 for single day participation

#### • **2026 ENTRY FEES:**

Entry fees for 2026 events will be identified both in the MotorsportsReg entry process for each event, as well as displayed on the hard-copy entry form specific for each event (found on Cal Club Web Site ([www.calclub.com](http://www.calclub.com))). Entry fees are heavily influenced by what the track charges for a weekend rental, as well as mandatory SCCA fees for Sanctions, insurance, and Worker Funds, combined with the general overhead to maintain equipment, and feed volunteer workers.

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## B. PAYMENTS & REFUNDS:

- **PAYMENT:** Cash, Check, Visa, and MasterCard are all accepted for payment. Checks should be made payable to: Cal Club
  - **ENTRY FEE PAYMENT:** Drivers who complete their registration online, via the motorsportsreg.com website, will be asked for a credit card, at the time of registration. Credit cards **will not be charged** until you arrive to on-site registration at the track. You may change the format of payment at that time. We accept check, credit card or cash. If bringing cash we ask you have the correct change.
  - **FEES WILL BE REFUNDED ONLY** if a car does not put a wheel on the track, Drivers must notify Registration before leaving the track
- **RETURNED CHECK FEE:** In addition to any bank charges incurred, there will be a \$35.00 flat-rate charge for all returned checks.
- **WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRY:** Fees will be refunded ONLY if a car does not put a wheel on the track. The driver must notify Registration promptly in writing at the event or via fax/e-mail explaining the facts of the withdrawal no later than five (5) business days from the date of the withdrawal to receive the refund.

## C. REGISTRATION LOCATION & HOURS:

- **Location: Location:** Cal Club will hold race weekend registration in the eastern most end of the main Circuit building. Just enter the building from the East side and you will find Laura, Ceci and the Team ready to get you going!
  - Friday: 3:00 - 7:00 PM
  - Saturday: 6:30 - 11:00 AM
  - Sunday: 7:00 - 9:00 AM

## D. PASSES:

- **DRIVERS must present their valid:**
  - SCCA Membership & SCCA Photo I.D. If someone doesn't have an SCCA Photo ID they can show a government issued Photo ID with verified SCCA membership/license per GCR 4.5.2.
  - Competition License, or Novice Permit.
  - SCCA Weekend Memberships will be available at Registration.
- **CREW must present their valid:**
  - SCCA Membership
- **HOT PIT PASSES:**
  - No "HOT PIT" passes will be issued after Registration closes.



## II. PADDOCK/PARKING INFORMATION

**A. PARKING/PADDOCKING** is a first-come, first-serve basis here at the Circuit. Please refer to the maps in the Driver Information Package you should have received. Basically, parking is similar to the Classic Buttonwillow track, with racers parking perpendicular to the paved roadway, with enough space to paddock the car on the pavement with parked off pavement tow rig/trailer. GRID will be on the east side of the tower, with GRID entry being from the most east, while TECH will be on the west side of the tower.

The only "off-limits" areas for parking/paddocking is in the rows next to the hot pit wall that host Grid and Tech. One thing to remember is to keep the paved roadways as open as wide as possible. Tow trucks often have to get disabled cars down the paved roads, so keeping your paddock spot limited to about a car width on the pavement and the rest in the grass/off-pavement areas is preferred.

**B. GARAGE SPACE** is nice in adverse weather conditions and garages can be reserved from the Track Office via a phone call (661) 764-5333.

**C. RV HOOKUPS:** The Circuit Track has many specific RV spots, with water and 30/50 AMP power. These can be reserved from the Track Office via a phone call (661) 764-5333.

### **D. OTHER SPECIFIC PADDOCK RULES:**

- Hot Pits are **RESTRICTED AREAS**. **HOT PASSES** (and SCCA membership) **ARE REQUIRED** and will be checked by grid personnel.
- Grid and Tech/Impound are **controlled areas**; please follow the directions of Race Officials
- **Grid** is closed to through traffic at all times.
- **Closed toed shoes** are required on the grid and over the wall on pit lane
- Unless signaling a car or tending to a car in the Hot Pits, **all persons must remain behind the pit wall.**
- **Smoking is prohibited** in the Hot Pits, Tech/Impound, Grid and all buildings.
- Spectators/participants with "**PADDOCK ONLY**" passes are not allowed over the pit wall at any time. No one may stand or sit on the pit or track walls anytime cars are running, either on the track or within the Hot Pits
- **USE OF SKATEBOARDS, ROLLER SKATES AND ROLLER BLADES IS PROHIBITED.** No one may operate a motorized vehicle of any kind without a valid Driver's License.
- **PAINTING ON ASPHALT, WALLS, OR BUILDINGS** is prohibited at each track.
- **Do not use tape** on walls, including rest rooms.



#### D. OTHER SPECIFIC PADDOCK RULES...CONTINUED:

- **PADDOCK ROADS:** There must be a clear and straight twenty-foot fire lane free of vehicles, awnings and equipment. Violators of this ordinance will be immediately required to clear the lane upon order of any Safety Steward or a Race Official of the club or track. Violators may also be cited and fined by County Fire or County or State Police agencies in addition to being required to move from the fire lane.
- **NO STAKES** or any other object may be driven into pavement at any track. Racing cars and other heavy objects must be supported with jack stands and such stands must have a wood, metal or other pad between it and the asphalt to distribute the weight and avoid damage to the surface. Drivers/entrants will be charged for asphalt repairs caused by improper or inadequate jack support.
- **SURFACE DAMAGE** caused by the spilling of fuel, solvent, oil or any other material may result in the track charging the driver and/or entrant for damage to the surface or required clean up. The driver's pit stall is the driver's/entrant's responsibility, not the crew members.
- **USED TIRES** may not be left at the tire shop or any other location within the track without the permission of the tire shop staff.
- **HAZARDOUS WASTE MATERIALS:** Any person bringing hazardous waste materials to the track must remove all such materials from the track. Whenever the track provides an official used oil dump station/fuel station, appropriate and approved fluids may be deposited. Charges and other sanctions will be assessed for violations at all tracks. Violators may also be subject to a minimum fine of \$500 per offense imposed by track management. When at The Circuit, one must use the "oil dump" at the Classic Track (behind the fuel pumps).
- **SPEED LIMIT:** There is a speed limit for all vehicles (including race cars, golf carts and two or three wheeled vehicles of any type) at each track. Speed limits are set by each track and strictly enforced by track and Club officials. All Club members and visitors are expected to identify and obey such limits. Club and track sanctions may run from warnings and fines to the violator's removal from the property depending on the severity of the offense.
- **AFTER HOURS ENTRY** at BRP is permitted. Entrance Deposit Tickets are available from the Security Guard at the gate. A refundable \$20.00 deposit per person is required (payable in cash or check). This deposit will be refunded per the instructions on the Deposit Ticket.
- **OVERNIGHT PARKING** is allowed when security is in place and appropriate credentials are in hand. RV spaces with power (30 and 50-amp breakers) and water are available for a fee at BRP. Call for reservations at 661-764-5333. **NO CAMPING IS PERMITTED AFTER EVENT IS OVER WITHOUT THE WRITTEN PERMISSION OF TRACK MANAGEMENT.**
- **PARKING IN PADDOCK:**
  - At BRP during dry weather: Park your support vehicles on the grass (dirt?), perpendicular to the asphalt to provide increased access for other competitors. (Please watch for and **avoid driving over sprinkler heads** while parking).
  - At BRP during wet weather or muddy conditions: **You may park support vehicles on the Pavement** if necessary. Racecars can be parked on the pavement at all tracks at all times.



### III. THE CIRCUIT TRACK SPECIFICS

- **CONFIGURATION:** The Circuit at Buttonwillow will be used for this Double Regional / Track Day event. The track runs in a clockwise direction and as a length of 2.56 miles. There are 10 staffed Flag Stations on The Circuit along with the Start/Finish crew.
- **BLACK FLAG:** Turn 5 on The Circuit will also be considered a Black Flag Station, and may show a Black Flag as directed by Race Control to a specified car/driver. Upon receipt of this Black Flag from Turn 5, pit immediately and report to the Black Flag Station in the hot pit lane.
- **PIT LANE:**
  - Drivers are to maintain a safe speed on Pit Lane with **absolutely** no racing.
  - Safe apparel must be worn in the pits at all times including shirts, pants (long pants strongly recommended) and closed-toe shoes.
  - Crew members on pit lane must display their event credentials at all times while on pit lane.
- **TRACK MAP:** A track Map showing the Flag Stations is included as the last page of these Supplemental Regulations.

### IV. ADDITIONAL OPERATION SPECIFICS

Any and all Cal Club "Track Days" will be run under the "2026 Track Day Rules." Additional rules are outlined in the following Supplemental Regulations. For complete SCCA Track Day Rules (TDR), please visit the SCCA website or follow the direct link here: <https://www.scca.com/downloads/44505-scca-track-event-rules/download>. These identified rules specify:

- Philosophy
- Driver Eligibility
- Helmet and Equipment Requirements
- Vehicle Preparation and Inspection
- Eligibility of Vehicles
- General Rules of the Road

The identified rules also include the Tech Sheet that is needed to be completed and returned to the Track Days Chief or its Staff at the track prior to the first session.

All participants must attend all Meetings that are held by the Track Days Chief and/or the Identified Instructors. As a minimum, a Meeting will be held each morning prior to the first on-track session and attendance is mandatory at this Meeting. Detailed information can be found in the Drivers Information Package available approximately 1 week prior to the event.

Based on entry numbers, there is a possibility that the Track Days Group may be split into two sub-groups - likely an experienced and a novice group. The Track Days Chief will make the split determination with concurrence from the overall Event Chief Steward.

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## V. VENDORS

### A. TIRES

- For Tires - The Buttonwillow Tire Shop will eagerly be awaiting your needs back at the Classic Track. You can contact the **Tire Shop** at 661-764-5333.

### B. FUEL

- Unfortunately, there is no "gas station" or "tire shop" on site at the Circuit Track (as of yet). One would have to venture over to the Classic Track to acquire fuel or tire service. In the future, the plan is to have similar facilities at the Circuit that currently reside at the Classic track when it comes to fuel and tires. Current Buttonwillow **Fuel prices** are: 91 = \$6.49; 110 Leaded = \$9.99; 101 Unleaded = \$9.99 all **subject to change**

### C. FOOD

- Inside the big building that centers the paddock is the Circuit's version of the Buttonwillow Café. Buttonwillow's Chef will be busy providing food and drink similar to the Classic Track. The benefit of the big building is larger indoor seating space to enjoy your food selections.

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

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
