The California Sports Car Club will host the first 2018 Hoosier Racing Tire Super Tour on the West Coast to be held at Buttonwillow Raceway. The Super Tour is the pinnacle of championship amateur road racing in North America leading to an invitation to the SCCA Runoffs. The Runoffs are to be held for the first time at Sonoma Raceway in the beautiful wine country of Sonoma, California, in October 2018.

This is a 3 day event with practice and qualifying on Friday, April 27th and 8 races Saturday, April 28th and Sunday, April 29th. 3 days of exciting racing, with live radio broadcast, segment timing and special awards.

Cal Club is the builder of Buttonwillow Raceway Park, which is celebrating its 24th anniversary, located in Buttonwillow, California just west of Bakersfield, and is a region of the Sports Car Club of America (SCCA). Cal Club is entering its 68th year, has nearly 2,000 members, and offers competition programs in road racing, autocross, track events, RallyCross and RoadRally.

Spectators are always welcome at the family friendly Buttonwillow Raceway Park. The "Park" has many amenities, grassy picnic and play areas, three story race control building containing a gift shop, restaurant with indoor seating, viewing area on the second story balcony as well as camping/viewing areas all around the track.
